



BEAUTY FOR ASHES



Isaiah 61:3

There are seasons when life leaves behind the ashes of disappointment, loss, regret, or heartbreak. Ashes represent what has been burned, broken, or consumed. They remind us of what once was, and at times they settle so heavily on the heart that it feels hard to breathe. Yet in the hands of the Master Stylist nothing is wasted.
